Feel the warmth with SkyVista Glow. This specialist glazing features a conductive coating which generates heat when an electrical current passes through. It is only available in SkyVista panels which feature within SupaLite Tiled Roofs.

The glow technology has been designed to emit radiant heat rather than convection heat, as used in traditional radiators. With running costs less than radiators.

What is Radiant Heat?

Radiant heating solutions have many benefits, it heats people and objects unlike convection that heats space. This allows you to control the temperature whilst making the most of natural light, using a wonderful combination of a solid roof and glass panels.

Radiant heat is much more comfortable than the convected heat provided by radiators, which draws cold air across the floor before heating it and then convects the warm air upwards towards the ceiling.

Doesn't The Heat Escape?

No. Unlike conventional heating sources, radiant heat from the roof structure effectively warms people and objects rather than just heating the surrounding space.

SIMPLICITY & PERFORMANCE



EXTERNAL LIGHTING - The unique design of the SupaLite roof incorporates an external fascia and deep soffit. Many customers choose external LEDs to be fitted into the soffit creating a feature that is both functional and aesthetically pleasing in the evenings. With long life and low running costs the external LEDs can be left on all night in areas where security is needed.



RIDGE SUPPORT BEAM - All roofs have to cater for 'Dead Load' (i.e. the weight of the roof).

When the deflections exceed an acceptable level, it is necessary to brace the structure with an additional support, namely a tie bar or ridge support beam.



COLOURED FASCIAS & SOFFITS - The soffit board is tucked away under the fascia board. It is usually the fascia and soffit that you see most of from street level. The SupaLite roof system incorporates these to match the existing property aesthetics, including most colour options. It also accommodates external soffit lights.



INTERNAL LIGHTING - LED ceiling lights are a sleek and stylish way to add energy efficient and up to date lighting to your home. LED bulbs have an impressive life span and use up to 90% less energy. These can be fitted in the ridge bulkhead or a pelmet closer to the eaves beam.



ROOF WINDOW - Roof lights and roof ventilation have been in popular use for the past 150 years.

Our high-quality materials, state of the art production techniques and excellent quality control ensure we provide durable, safe and functional roof windows. The internal colour options of our roof windows are white or pine.

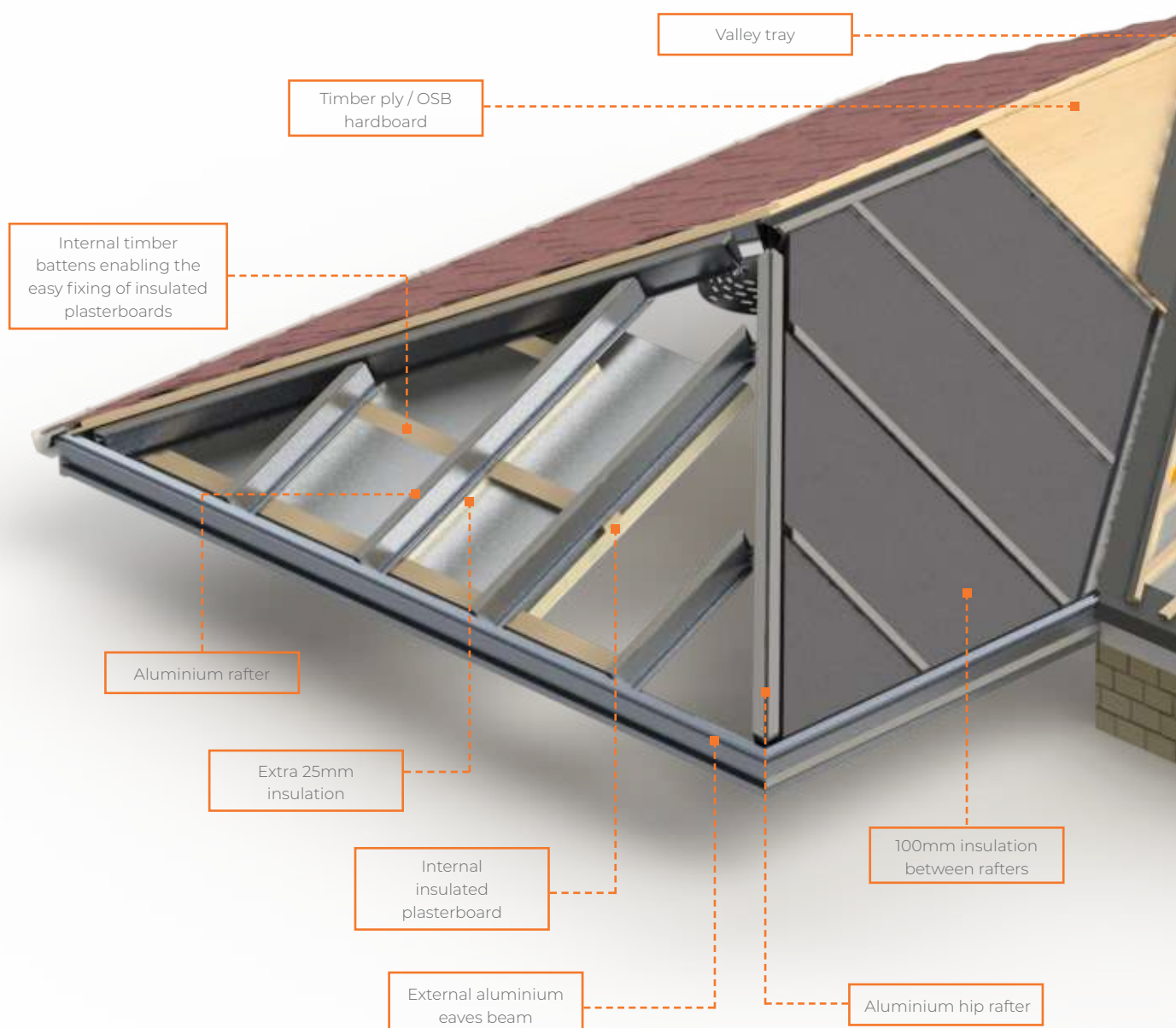

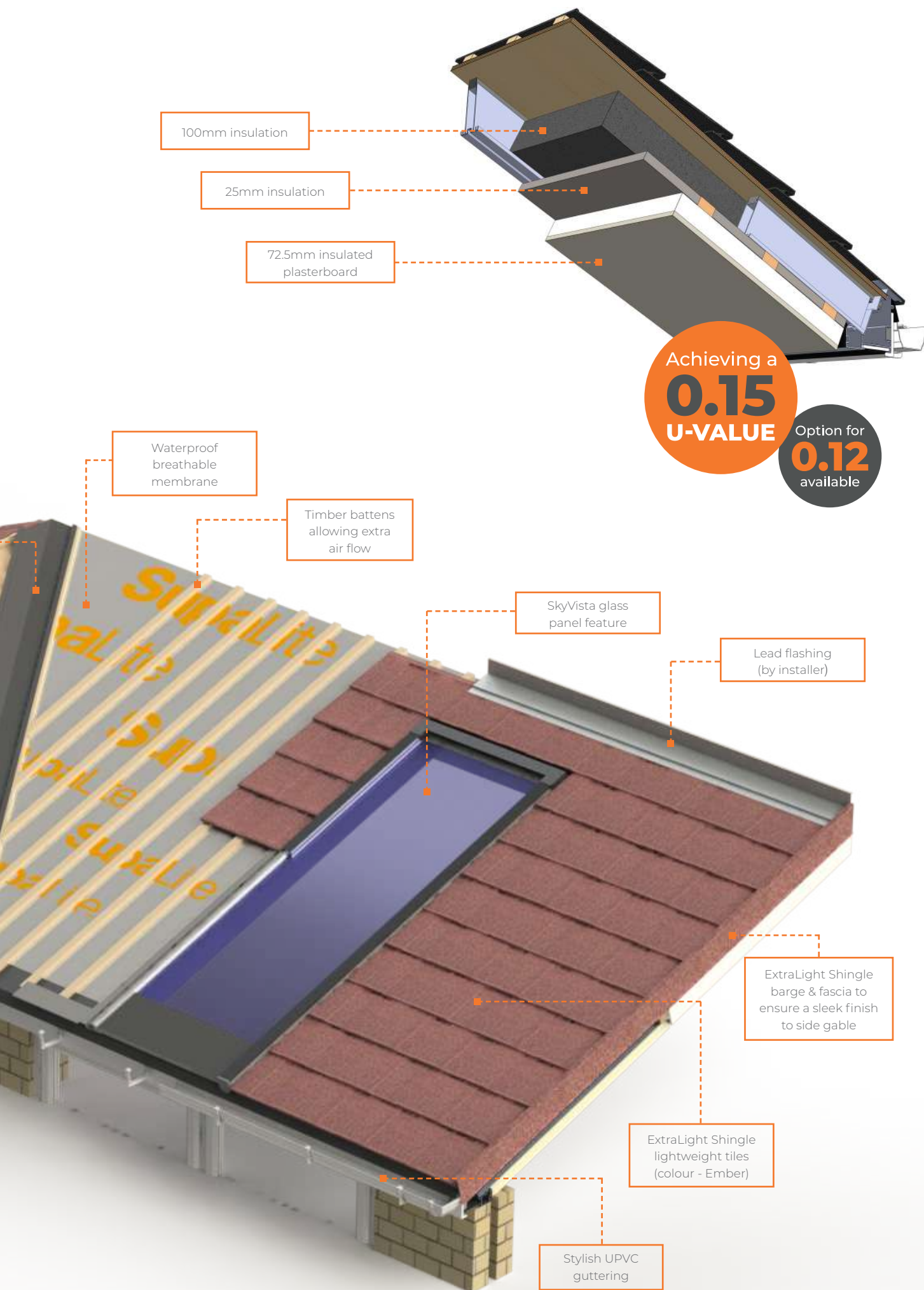

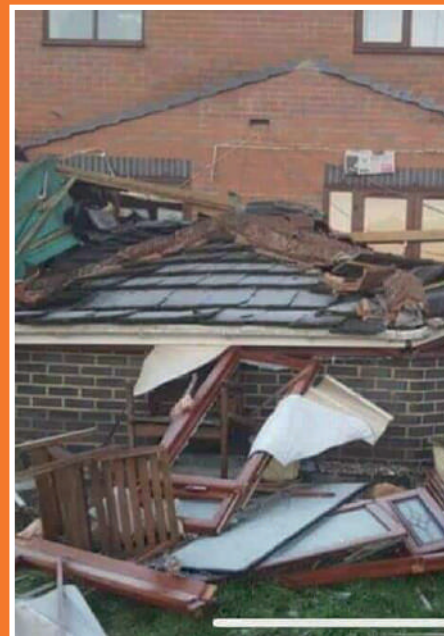

The Dangers of **CLAD OVERS**

What is a Clad Over?

A clad over is when an installer tries to pass off basic timber installation material, low-grade tiles and plasterboard for a real tiled roof, ultimately causing harm to both the conservatory and the homeowner. Rather than replacing the whole conservatory roof, the installer will take out the old polycarbonate sheets, directly fix timber battens to the pre-existing roof and plaster over to mask any potential issues.

There are four different types of clad over...



Internal Clad Over (Clad Under)

Also known as an under clad, this is where the existing conservatory framework is left in place and a hollow cladding is pinned to this framework. It acts as a false ceiling but causes condensation and doesn't really insulate a conservatory structure, it just covers the roof.



External Clad Over

Also known as an over clad, this is where the existing conservatory framework is left in place and lightweight tiles are fitted over the existing roof. This puts more weight on the roof structure and the existing roof spars are not designed to take the extra weight.



External & Internal Clad Over

This is when an installation features a combination of an under clad and over clad. Both options can be extremely expensive for what they are. They also do not comply with Building Regulations.



Solid Panel Clad Over

This is where the existing glass is replaced with solid panels. However, with U-values of 0.29, these panels are less thermally efficient compared to other tiled roofs and lack an internal finish.

All our independent installers across the UK ensure your old roof is removed before the SupaLite roof is fitted.

REPLACEMENT ROOF CHECKLIST

- ☐ **Ask** for details about the roof construction, including a detailed specification. Ensure you have seen cross section samples of the roof system.
- ☐ **Ensure** you compare the roof weight and u-values when quoted by installers.
- ☐ **Understand** your options to what is and isn't available when it comes to design. For example, introducing glass panels for extra light or choice of lightweight tiles.
- ☐ **Ask** about Building Regulations and legal requirements of any proposed work. You will need a Building Regulations certificate if you ever sell your house.
- ☐ **Monitor** the progress and quality of the work daily. Ensure old roofing materials are removed completely before new materials are installed.
- ☐ **Verify credentials.** View projects, reviews, references, ratings, certifications and licenses.

THINGS TO CONSIDER

THERMAL EFFICIENCY

Does the new structure achieve the correct u-value for insulation properties?

Tip: Discuss with your installer what insulation options / materials there are and what u-values they achieve. The minimum requirement to meet building regulations is 0.15 in England, 0.13 in Wales & 0.12 in Scotland.

WARRANTY

What guarantee will you get and will your home insurance pay out if there's a problem?

Tip: Always ask for proof that your product has an insurance backed guarantee (IBG) for at least 10 years.

CONDENSATION

Are there thermal barriers and enough air ventilation in place? Ask to see a small product sample if needed for proof of this.

Tip: You can always ask your installer to point out the thermal breaks in the system.

STRUCTURAL INTEGRITY / CALCULATIONS

Can the new roof structure withstand wind and snow loadings? If in doubt, request structural calculations for the roof. If this is a tried and tested system, these will be available.

Tip: Check that local Building Control has been informed before the conversion starts. Obtain a Building Regulations Conformance Certificate and file in a safe place.

WEIGHT

Clad over companies simply remove your polycarbonate or glass and clad over a structure designed to carry a lot less weight. Tiled roofs need to be stronger to prevent plaster cracking and total roof collapse.

Tip: Always ask your installer for the total weight of the new roof per Sq.M

Frequently **ASKED QUESTIONS**

Everything you might want to know about the SupaLite Tiled Roof System

Do I get a guarantee with the SupaLite roof?

We provide a 10-year product guarantee on our SupaLite roofs to the installation company. The installation company should issue their own guarantee as the SupaLite product guarantee does not cover any installation work.

Do I need to get planning permission to install a SupaLite conservatory roof?

Planning permission is generally not required to install a SupaLite conservatory roof, if you are only replacing the roof on your existing conservatory. However, if your existing conservatory needed permission you may need permission to change the roof.

What is the weight, per square meter, for a SupaLite tiled roof?

The weight of the tiled roof is 46kg per m², however, this may vary by roof style.

Will having a SupaLite conservatory roof increase the value of my home?

A SupaLite conservatory roof could significantly increase the value of your home, especially with a Building Regulation Certificate.

Typically, how long does it take to install the SupaLite conservatory roof?

Typically, it would take 2 - 3 days to install a SupaLite conservatory roof for a standard sized 4m x 4m Edwardian style conservatory, excluding plastering & internal finish.

Will it make the room darker if I have a SupaLite conservatory roof installed?

There is a possibility that your room may be darker once you replace your existing roof with a SupaLite conservatory roof, but there are ways of making your new room lighter. This includes painting the ceiling white, installing internal spot lights, Roof Windows or SkyVista glass panels.
